Williamstown: Airdrie's next big thing

"There is nothing else quite like it in Airdrie."

That's how Judy Rohatyn, marketing manager for Vesta Properties, describes Williamstown.

Williamstown is a brand new one-of-a-kind community located in the north-west corner of Airdrie that will be unveiled in October.

"It is a new community nestled next to 43.5 acres of Nose Creek Environmental reserve land," said Rohatyn.

"The whole community backs on to environmental reserve that will be forever preserved. You can walk out of your home and into a beautiful, preserved, pristine green space."

The community connects with kilometers of regional trails and is the perfect setting for an active lifestyle, she added.

There is a total of 60 acres of open space in the community including pathways, parks and playgrounds.

Williamstown will be home to more than 1,000 families when complete and is a sustainable community featuring a wide variety of housing types, catering to the many different family life stages.

The community will be created by three builders including Vesta Properties, Talisman Homes and Douglas Homes.

"It will have the feeling of an established neighbourhood with a variety of single family and townhome styles," said Rohatyn.

Williamstown features decorative street lanterns professional landscaping and trail heads leading to the parks.

The community's theme, 'Community that connects with nature' says it all.

The arts and crafts architecture cre-

ates a neighbourhood with attention to detail and heritage inspired colour schemes. Townhomes feature a classic colonial design that will appeal to a variety of tastes.

"A little bit of everything and something for everybody."

Inspired by strong historical roots, the master planned community gets its name from William MacKenzie, the rail-

way engineer who named the city of Airdrie.

"There will be a feeling of heritage throughout the community," said Rohatyn.

One of the features that make Williamstown unique is the Discovery Centre - an interactive innovative information centre that showcases what Williamstown will look like, highlighting

its many features.

"It will be a must see," said Rohatyn.

The first opportunity to purchase a home in Williamstown will be in October, with special introductory offers.

"Be the first to secure your lot and home," said Rohatyn.
